

**REJECTION TURNED TO JOY**

Tony Compolo tells the story of the "reject prom." It all began when John Carlson, a Lutheran Minister in Minnesota, believed that senior proms excluded many young adults. It had become an elitist affair for the popular and wealthy. The losers and less fortunate youth stayed away. Carlson planned a party for all those who didn't have a date or couldn't afford to go to the prom. He called it the "Reject Prom." It was such a great time the youth wanted it repeated the following year. Thus the "reject prom" became a local tradition. In time it got press coverage and Timex Corporation gave watches to every kid that attended. Other companies joined in and gave gifts as well. In a matter of time the popularity of the "reject prom" exceeded the high school prom, which by comparison was very boring. Rejection was turned into joy.

Carlson's cornerstone faith made a huge difference in the lives of these youth. His "love ethic" helped them to overcome their rejection.
