If you would like either Pastor Bill or Pastor Jeff to visit, please let us know. If not, let us know so that we can remember you in our personal prayers.

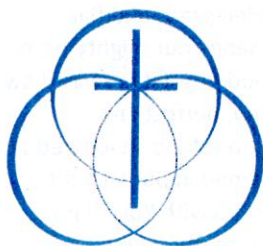

Ascension Sunday is the observance of Jesus Christ's bodily ascension into heaven, celebrated on the Sunday following Ascension Thursday in some Christian traditions.

Meaning and Significance

Ascension Sunday commemorates the Christian belief that Jesus ascended bodily into heaven forty days after his resurrection, marking the completion of his earthly mission and his exaltation at the right hand of God the Father (Acts 1:9-11). This event signifies that heaven is the true home for believers and that Jesus has gone ahead to prepare a place for humanity. It is part of the ecumenical feasts shared across many Christian denominations, alongside Easter, Pentecost, and the Passion.

Timing and Observance

Traditionally, Ascension Day is celebrated on a Thursday, the fortieth day after Easter Sunday. However, in some Christian communities, the celebration is transferred to the following Sunday, known as Ascension Sunday, to allow broader participation. This Sunday falls within Ascensiontide, the ten-day period between the Ascension and Pentecost.
