If you would like either Pastor Bill or Pastor Jeff to visit, please let us know. If not, let us know so that we can remember you in our personal prayers.

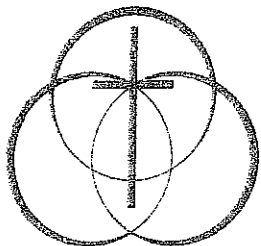

### **CHRIST HAS COME TO FREE US**

The man with an unclean spirit understands who Jesus is better than anyone else in the room. He is on the margins of society and the margins of sanity, but he knows exactly who Jesus is. Remember that the disciples don't figure it out until Chapter 8, when Peter says, "You are the messiah, the one sent by God." This man of unclean spirit is way ahead of everyone, and he wants to know, "What are you going to do with people like me? Are you going to destroy us?"

"Be silent and come out of him!" And then the man convulses and cries out loudly and the unclean spirit leaves him. I still have no idea what an unclean spirit is, but I am impressed. Mark still hasn't told us a thing about what Jesus taught, but he has showed us that Jesus had a power over things that people label as unclean. Mark is making this point: that the will and purpose of God present in Jesus is engaging and fighting against the purposes of evil that exist among humanity. This battle is not fought just at the highest levels of government or industry, but right in the midst of common folk like us. The battle of good versus evil, right versus wrong, life versus death happens amidst the people who are gathered for worship. Christ has come to shatter the domineering designs that shackle people to lower standards for life than God intends. Christ has come to free us from the demons like prejudice and pride, greed and guile. Christ is among us, whenever we gather in church, to demonstrate a power among us. If we devote ourselves to an thing less than a divinely directed destiny, we have missed the goal of faith.

### **CALL TO PRAYER**

### **SAMARITANS PURSE FACEBOOK POST**

#### **Disaster Relief Specialists Are Headed To Nepal**

#### **To Work With Trusted Christian Partners On The Ground**

Devastating flash flooding killed hundreds of people in Nepal and along the Nepal-Tibet border this week. Nearly 2,000 people or more remain missing. An untold number of families are in need.

Samaritan's Purse has sent a team of disaster relief specialists to Nepal to work with trusted Christian partners on the ground, whom we also worked with after the terrible 2015 earthquake and its aftershocks. We are already helping with emergency feeding. An airlift is also in the works to provide relief items such as tarps, blankets, solar lights, hygiene kits, and more.

Samaritan's Purse President Franklin Graham posted the following on Facebook on Aug. 26: "The media is calling the scenes of catastrophic flash flooding on the Nepal-Tibet border 'apocalyptic.' The numbers are not yet fully known, but more than 150 people are already confirmed dead, with many missing, including hundreds of tourists. ... Stranded residents were being rescued off rooftops by helicopter. Take a moment to stop and pray for the people of this region and for families anxiously awaiting news of their loved ones." The death toll has now risen above 500 (Aug. 28) and is expected to increase.

Search-and-rescue operations continue. Scientists believe part of a glacier collapsed to the valley floor of this remote and mountainous region, which caused the equivalent of a 5.2 magnitude earthquake. Such a tremendous landslide pushed a terrifying and deadly wall of water down through the narrow river canyons and beyond for many miles, destroying buildings, homes, bridges, and roads.

There are fears of additional flooding in the region.

Please pray for more survivors to be found in the coming hours. Pray for safe access to bring relief in Jesus' Name alongside our partners. Finally, lift up families around the world who are grieving the loss of loved ones.
