Dear Snyder's Church Family and Friends

The phrase "What A Difference A Day Makes" applies so real to us in this month of September. Most of us remember September 11, 2001, 25 years ago when disaster struck the Twin Towers in New York City, The Pentagon, and a farm field in Western Pennsylvania by terrorists who wanted to do extreme harm to our nation. Over 3,000 Americans died that day.

My good friend, Brad Knepp, who was Pastor at Mt. Holly Springs left for NYC that same day and called me the next day and said "Pippy, you need to be here to help!" Brad is the nephew of Kay Anderson and Linda Morrow. I left on the 12th and spent two weeks at Ground Zero in ministry to hurting people – family members worried about their loved ones, police and firemen who were worried about their co-workers and the pain of so many. Being raised in Central New York, I know that New Yorkers can be the most miserable and unkind people on the earth....but this was not the case. Everyone treated those of us who had responded with courtesy and respect. I stood in the "hole" at ground zero next to police officers and firemen as bodies were brought out with all the dignity that could be afforded to them. Mayor Rudy came to the site many times in the day. President Bush came. I had two men from the church here in Carlisle that I was serving that were carpet pad salesmen in NYC who came and picked me up one night and took me to Little Italy for supper and I sure needed that break.

Now we celebrate 25 years and I am hopeful that our nation will remember with dignity on this day. On the back of this page you will find an article that I have laminated in my Bible called "What A Difference A Day Makes" an email after the disaster. Let us not forget that it's America first and America always. God bless you.

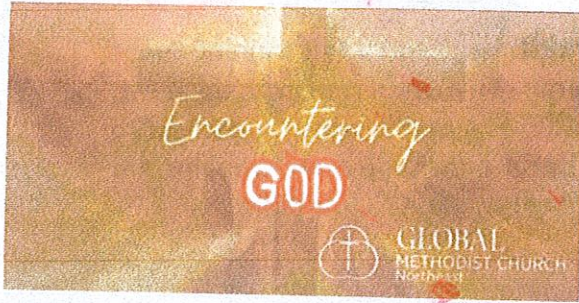

The Beautiful Ways the Holy Spirit Moved at Camp Encounter 2026!



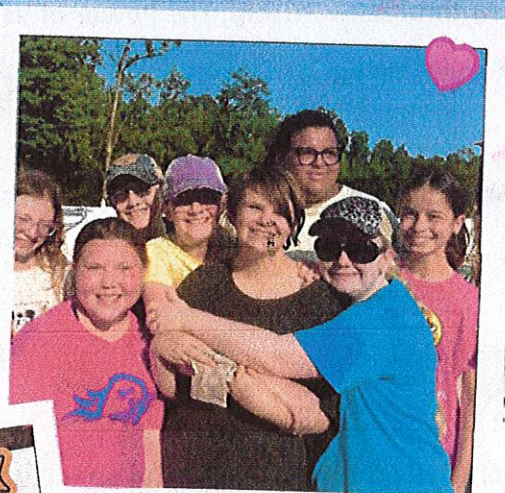
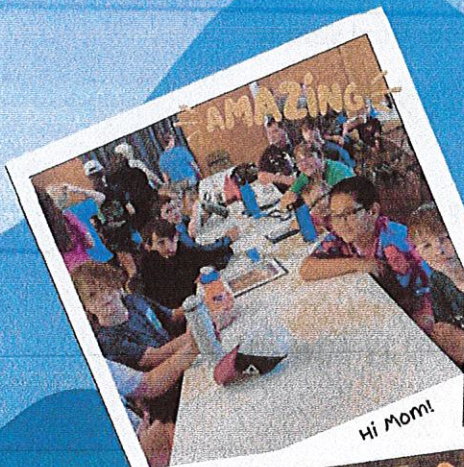

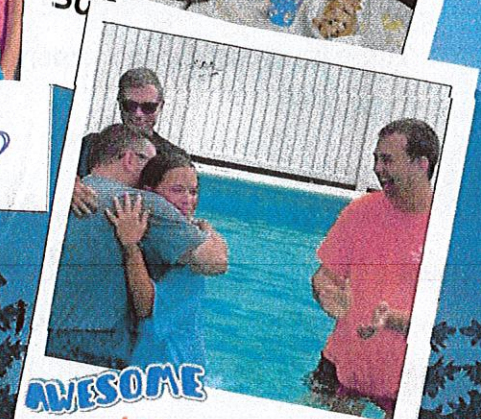
