SECTION 2: STRUCTURE OF THE CHURCH COUNCIL: The structure of Snyder's Church shall be that of its predecessor entity, Snyder's United Methodist Church, with appropriate changes for current use. See Addendum attached.

Term of office is in accord with the calendar year and for one year or remainder of year if elected mid-year.

Exceptions for this time frame are members of Trustees, Staff-Parish Relations Committee, and Nominations Committee, who are elected for three year staggering terms.

SECTION 3: ANNUAL MEETING: The Annual Meeting of the Church Organization shall be at a date and time as the Church Council may determine.

SECTION 4: RESIGNATIONS: Any member of the Church Council may resign at any time by submitting a written notice. Any member may be removed by a vote of the membership present at a duly called meeting of the Church Council.

SECTION 5: COMMITTEES: Committees of the elected chairpersons of Worship, Missions, Women's Ministry and Education. These may have church members and as appropriate non-church members for the tasks allotted to them.

SECTION 6: FINANCE COMMITTEE: The Finance Committee shall be comprised of the Finance Chairperson, the Treasurer, and the Financial Secretary. They shall be responsible for the Annual Audit and the Counters each time an offering is received. These persons should be two un-related adults.

Adoption by majority vote [of By-Laws] of members present at meeting to adopt By-Laws and elect Church Council.

SECTION 3: QUORUM: A quorum consists by the presence of those in attendance at a duly called meeting, so long as at least three persons are present. Passage of matter is by a simple majority unless noted in prior announcement and the number for a quorum may be thus changed for the meeting.

SECTION 4: PRESIDING OVER MEETINGS: The Chairperson of the Church Council shall preside at all meetings. In the absence of the Chairperson, an acting Chairperson shall be chosen by the members present.

SECTION 5: BY-LAWS: The Temporary Chairperson shall call a special meeting of the church or at an Annual Meeting to adopt or amend the By-Laws. A simple majority vote is required for adoption of amendment.

SECTION 6: Any use of the property must be granted by a meeting of the Church Council and may be written as a General Policy; Policy of use for members and non-members.

SECTION 7: A majority of all members is required for dissolution of the corporation. IRS/Rev language on dissolution.

ARTICLE IV CHURCH COUNCIL

SECTION 1: GENERAL POWERS: The business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by and under the direction of the Church Council, which may exercise all such authority and powers of the Corporation and do all lawful things which are not prohibited by the Certificate of Incorporation. Some duties may be delegated by the Board for day to day operation but shall be exercised under the ultimate direction of the Church Council.

ARTICLE 1 – NAME AND PURPOSE

SECTION 1: NAME OF ORGANIZATION: SNYDER'S CHURCH

SECTION 2: PURPOSE: The purpose of the corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which non-profit corporations may be organized under the exclusively for religious, charitable, educational, scientific, and/or literary purposes within the meaning of section 501[c] [3] of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended [the Code]. The focus will be on ministry and community outreach.

ARTICLE II OFFICES

SECTION 1: REGISTERED OFFICE: The registered office of the Corporation within the State of Pennsylvania, shall be located at 1724 New Bloomfield Road, New Bloomfield, Pennsylvania.

ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP

SECTION 1: Open to all persons who support the purposes of this corporation as set forth in the certificate of incorporation and who comply with such membership policies.

SECTION 2: All Church Council meetings shall be open to the entire membership of the organization, but only those who have been elected to the various offices of the Church Council shall vote, except if the meeting is a Church Conference at which all members may vote.

Regularly scheduled meetings should be noted in the bulletin and/or newsletter.

Un-scheduled meetings need to be in the bulletin for two Sundays in advance of the meeting or notified by mail.
