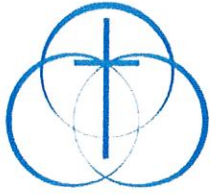

- To all of the ladies and men who helped in any way for the Annual Free-For-All. Once again this special ministry of Snyder's Church was a blessing to so many people that we were able to help.
- Barb Perkins reports that Wayne and Gary laid paving stones around the outside of the newly finished outdoor sign [painted by Linda Morrow with assistance from Linda Pipp and RaeAnne Hudson]. Rubber roofing material was placed on the inside of the paving stones and white stones have been put on the inside of the pavers.
- Paving stones have been placed around the flag pole and memorial plaque, with rubber roofing material and white paving stones.
- Dwayne and Bev who are and will be trimming the trees in compliance with the Insurance Company request.
- The Insurance Company has made some necessary recommendations for our property and safety. The Electric Panel boxes will be changed as the ones we have are a fire hazard. Gary will take care of this. We are also placing concrete bumpers from Island Concrete in the parking spaces around our building that are directly facing the church building. A cost quote for seal-coating the places in our parking lot that are cracking is being secured.
- A new light to replace the broken one in the ceiling just outside the church office has been installed.

Closing June 28, 2023

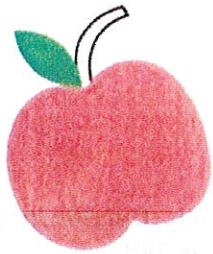
Here is a break-down of the total costs for Disaffiliation from the United Methodist Church. Our Attorney Mark Allshouse, and Darryl Graham and Barb Perkins settled with the Conference on June 28th.

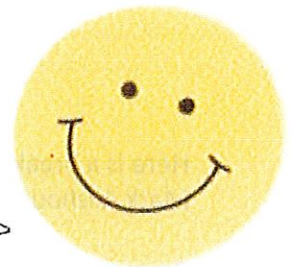
We were also blessed in this whole disaffiliation process to have one of our church families anonymously donate a new laptop computer/program so that our Treasurer doesn't have to use her own personal computer. This has greatly added to the abilities in our ministry at Snyder's Church.

We were fortunate enough [truly blessed indeed!] to over the past several years able to save enough money to purchase bank CD's and we surrendered enough to cover these costs. Now we are doing some of the special repair projects, etc around the church that need to be done. We may surrender another CD to help with the expenses if there is not enough money in the current building fund. We continue to count on the faithful support giving of our entire membership to make all of this possible. We would welcome some very generous gifts to the Building Fund to help with these costs.

Enclosed in this newsletter you will find 2 self-addressed envelopes for you to mail your tithes and offerings if unable to be with us, along with 1 of our tithe and offering envelopes. Darryl Graham as chair of the Finance Committee, along with all members of the Committee express once again our deepest and prayerful appreciation for your generous givings to Snyder's Church. Your faithful giving will enable us to continue our ministry to the community, to the county and to the world in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior. Under the old United Methodist Church system we were paying 17% of our income to cover the Shares of Ministry [Apportionments] for the annual conference and the general church. As a member of the Global Methodist Church our obligation is 1% for the General Church and 1% for the Provisional Conference.....a significant savings to us at Snyder's Church.
