If you would like either Pastor Bill or Pastor Jeff to visit, please let us know. If not, let us know so that we can remember you in our personal prayers.

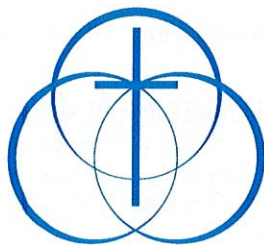

GETTING ON BOARD -- TEAMWORK

Herman Ostry's barn floor was under 29 inches of water, because of a rising creek. He needed to move the 17,000 lbs barn to a new foundation, 143 feet away. So, he devised a lattice work of steel tubing, nailing, welding, and bolting it to the inside and outside of the barn. Hundreds of handlebars were attached. On the day of the moving, 344 people showed up, and after one practice lift, they were able to walk the barn up the incline, in just three minutes. Because of teamwork, each lifter carried less than fifty pounds of the barn.
