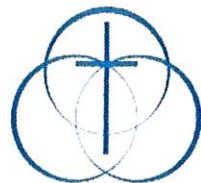

The Vision of Making the Northeast GMC a Prayer-Based Movement

Three powerful stories of faith were shared during our February 19th Prayer Meeting. We hope they will be an encouragement and guide for the importance and power of prayer.

John Wesley had a daily practice of praying at 4am at the kneeler in his bedroom. The fire of revival that would come to be known as "Methodism" began here as Wesley lit the fireplace, then kneeled in prayer. This is our DNA and we want to restore this DNA in the Northeast Global Methodist Church.

Charles Finney and Daniel Nash were part of the 2nd Great Awakening which took place in the early 1800s in New England and Appalachia. Charles Finney was a gifted revivalist preacher who brought hundreds of thousands of people to Christ; however, his partner, Daniel Nash, was a prayer warrior who would travel to a town weeks prior to hosting a revival to pray over the town, the people and Finney. When Nash died, this powerful prayer ended, and as did the revivals.

Watchman Nee was a Chinese pastor and writer who led a phenomenal expansion of the church in China. They were united in prayer, making it central to their movement which lasted for 30 years bringing countless people to Christ. Nee said *"Prayer lays the rails upon which the purpose and plans of God will travel."*

If we make the Northeast Global Methodist Church a prayer-based movement, we will "lay the rails", inviting God's purpose and plans into our midst. If we stop praying, so will stop the movement of the Global Methodist Church. We invite you to join us in prayer as we prepare for our Convening Annual Conference on April 11 -13, 2024!

But I am afraid lest they should only exist as a dead sect, having the form of religion without the power.
