If you would like either Pastor Bill or Pastor Jeff to visit, please let us know. If not, let us know so that we can remember you in our personal prayers.

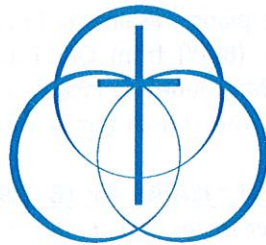

SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENT

The Susquehanna Orthodox Network [UMC] made the following report on May 22nd. "Delegates to the General Conference from the Susquehanna Conference reported in the past week that the disaffiliation paragraph 2553 was eliminated by General Conference and eliminated as an option for an individual church to separate from the UMC with their property but that our Conference will not allow paragraph 2549, the Church closure paragraph, to be utilized despite the fact that other Conferences are doing so. The DS's issued this statement: 'In the Susquehanna Conference there is no longer a process in which a local church may leave the United Methodist Church with their facilities.'" *This decision comes as devastating as churches were told to "wait and see" the results of GC. Even though the teams sent out by the Bishops and also the District Superintendents had encouraged such a wait. Snyder's Church members need to be in Prayer for those who are now disappointed and continue to invite them to our Church where The Bible Is The Word Of God; Jesus Is The Only Way To Salvation; Prayer Is Essential; and Evangelism Is Our Mission*
