If you would like either Pastor Bill or Pastor Jeff to visit, please let us know. If not, let us know so that we can remember you in our personal prayers.

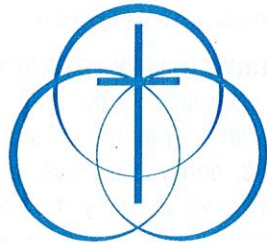

A GREAT DAD

One of the greatest preachers and pastors who ever lived was Dwight L. Moody. He was a man of uncompromising principle, but he was also a great dad. His son Willie reported that it was not unusual for Dwight L. Moody to come to one of his children lying in bed late at night and say something like this, "Are you awake? I can't go to sleep till I talk to you. I'm sorry I lost my temper." As a teenager Willie wrote this tribute to his famous father.

"Other kids tell me they cannot go to their dads and just talk and hope to be understood; they say they can't because their dads are 'always right' and they are 'always wrong.' They can't talk to their dads the way I can talk to you. I could always talk to you. You always understood. There was nothing I could not tell you."

Of course Willie is describing here a father who has more than a mere time. He also has tenderness and a willingness to admit it when he has made a mistake; but simply taking time is the first step along the journey to successful parenting.
