If you would like either Pastor Bill or Pastor Jeff to visit, please let us know. If not, let us know so that we can remember you in our personal prayers.

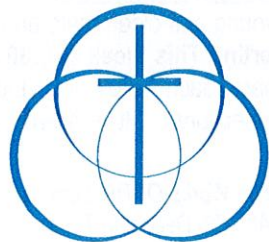

## NOT WELL RECEIVED

A Baptist pastor fresh out of seminary was assigned to a small church in the  
hills of Kentucky. In his first sermon, he condemned gambling, especially  
betting on the horses. The sermon was not well received. "You see,
