

### **RISING TO THE OCCASION!**

Have you heard the story about the elderly woman who lived in a small town in East Texas ... who had car trouble on the way to the supermarket one morning? Her car stalled at a stop sign ... she tried everything to get her car started again, but no luck. Suddenly, a man in a pick-up truck came up behind her and with obvious agitation he started honking his horn at her impatiently. She doubted her efforts to get her car going. She pumped the gas, turned the ignition, but still no luck... the man in the pick-up truck continued to honk his horn constantly and loudly. I love what the elderly woman did. Very calmly she got out of her car, walked back to the pick-up and motioned for the man to lower his window and then politely she said: "I'll make a deal with you. If you will start my car for me I'll be happy to honk your horn for you!"

Now, that is what you call "Rising to the occasion!" and that is precisely what Jesus does here in Luke 10. The lawyer was "testing" Jesus ... honking his horn loudly. He was trying to trap Jesus and trip Him up with a loaded question ... but Jesus (as He so often did) rose to the occasion and passed the test with flying colors ... and in so doing ... He reminded the people back then (and us today) of what is the main thing in the Christian faith.
