

After warning for decades that the world would end within this present generation, the leaders of the sect announced in December 1995 that they have softened their position. When we reflected on the scriptures, we decided that he was talking about his generation rather than ours." The reason for their urgency no longer exists. Lent

March 5<sup>th</sup> – The 1<sup>st</sup> day of Lent. It marks the beginning of a period of reflection and penance. In the Bible, sprinkling oneself with ashes was traditionally a sign of one's sorrow for having committed sin.

The six week period leading up to Easter not counting Sundays. It starts on March 5<sup>th</sup> (Ash Wed.) and ends on Holy Sat. (April 19<sup>th</sup>)

Holy Week

Final week of Lent, beginning with Passion/Palm

Sunday and ending with Holy Saturday.

Pasch

The Great Three Days from sunset Holy Thur. through sunset Easter day are the climax of Lent and a bridge into the Easter Season. These days proclaim the paschal mystery of Jesus Christ's passion, death and resurrection.
