If you would like either Pastor Bill or Pastor Jeff to visit, please let us know. If not, let us know so that we can remember you in our personal prayers.

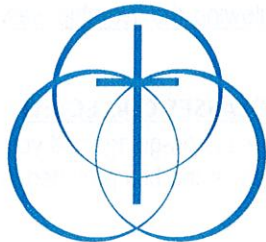

I want you to think for a moment about all of the things you can't see:

** Microwaves, X-Rays, Ultraviolet Rays, Oxygen, Carbon Monoxide,
