If you would like either Pastor Bill or Pastor Jeff to visit, please let us know. If not, let us know so that we can remember you in our personal prayers.

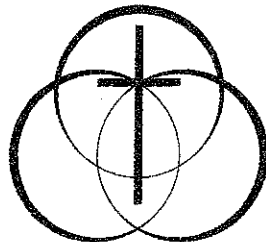

WESLEY'S CONUNDRUM

There is an interesting note in the writings of John Wesley, patron saint of the Methodists. Wesley had a most enviable problem. He was committed to a life of relative austerity. Christ was indeed first in his life. He saw how material possessions could be a negative encumbrance to his ministry. Yet his writings made him quite prosperous. With this insight in mind he stated on one occasion, "I do not see how it is possible...for any revival to continue long. Religion must necessarily produce industry and these cannot but produce riches. As riches increase so will pride, anger and the love of the world." Do you see the beautiful irony in his words? When people are spiritually revived, they will live more responsibly which can't help but make them prosper, which in turn is a danger to their souls.
