A Message from Good News

On the Way



Across the country we are seeing that where bishops are allowing a somewhat fair process for disaffiliation,

many churches are leaving the UM Church. Most of those are joining the Global Methodist Church. We estimate over 1,500 churches will disaffiliate by the end of this year.

The good news is that some of the bishops that were unreasonable in their exit requirements are now offering terms that are, if not fair, at least "doable" for many congregations.

I'm proud of our pastors and our churches that understand that what's at stake is "the faith once and for all delivered to the saints" and that are willing to pay a price to leave a denomination that is willing to compromise the Gospel.

Recently I had the opportunity to speak via social media to Filipino United Methodists in the U.S., the Philippines, Europe, the Middle East, and Africa. Their context for leaving is different than ours, but their hearts are the same. They also yearn to be in a church that is unashamed of the Gospel.

I was recently asked after speaking to a church, "The centrists are saying the Africans are staying UMC, is that right?" I responded, "It's amazing how pastors who have never worked with the Africans and who have never been to Africa are suddenly experts on what the Africans are going to do." Our partners on the ground who lead the African church tell us many African United Methodists will land in the GMC. They want to be part of an international, Wesleyan church that is committed to Jesus as Lord and that views the Bible as God's word.

I tell you about the Philippines and Africa because I believe the church of God should look like the Kingdom of God. And the GMC will.

In addition to the Philippines and Africa, we have had churches in Latin America with no previous connection to the UMC inquire about joining. And one European annual conference and one district have already transferred to the GMC.

The GMC is well on the way to becoming a truly global church, demonstrating that the Gospel has the power to unite diverse people for the glory of our Lord and Savior.

I am grateful for your past generosity which has allowed Good News to play a leading role in guiding Methodists into a faithful future.

There is still much work to do. Thank you for your continued support.
